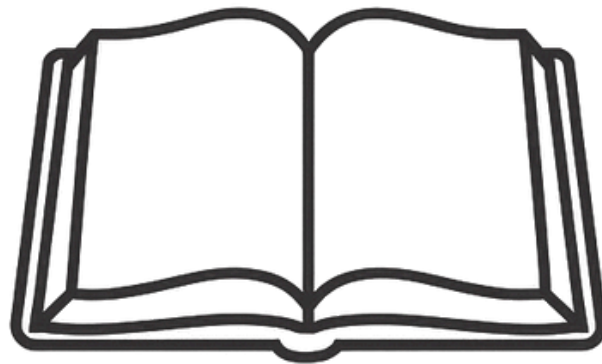

21-Day SOAP Bible Study: Gospel of John

Welcome to the Journey

You're holding more than just a workbook. You're holding an invitation to slow down, open your heart, and meet Jesus in a fresh, personal way.

This 21-day SOAP study through the Gospel of John is designed to help you engage Scripture with simplicity and depth. Whether you're new to the Bible or returning with a renewed desire, you don't need to be an expert. You just need to be present.

Each day focuses on one chapter from John, giving you space to reflect, respond, and pray. The SOAP method (**Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer**) helps you listen closely to God's voice and consider what His Word means for your life today.

Don't rush. Don't worry about having the "perfect answer." Just begin. Let the Word of God come alive in you.

Here's how to begin:

- Set aside 10–20 minutes a day.
- Start with prayer: Ask God to speak to you through His Word.
- Read the day's chapter in the Gospel of John.
- Read the day's Chapter in *That You May Believe: A Chapter-by-Chapter Devotional on the Gospel of John*
- Use the SOAP prompts to reflect on what you read.

You may want to keep a Bible, journal, highlighter, and quiet space nearby. Above all, bring a willing heart. God will do the rest.

Let me pray for you

Thank You for the person holding this journal. You know their heart, their questions, their hopes, and their hunger for more of You. I pray that as they open Your Word, You would open their eyes. Let Your truth speak clearly. Let Your love be felt deeply.

As they walk through these pages, let it be more than a study—let it be a step forward in their journey of faith. Grow them in wisdom, in trust, and in love for You. Remind them that this time in Your Word matters and that You are shaping them into the person You've called them to be.
